SEPTEMBER MEETING NOTES

Fourteen members enjoyed a short but substantive meeting on September 12th. **GCH Ron Osinski** submitted a financial report covering June thru August. The Business and Charity accounts are both in the black. **SE Barone** will send out dues notices for 2020 in October.

A motion was passed to pay \$3312 to Baltimore for our 2020 *per capita* assessment. That covers 72 members at \$46 each. Caravan business expenses totaled \$211 covering the parade oasis and newsletter stamps.

Final financial reports for both the 2019 bowling and golf outings were handed out as submitted by the event chairmen. Both functions were very profitable but unfortunately all chairmen for 2019 have chosen to "retire" and Sancho will need new volunteers in 2020.

GC Leo Osinski read a 'Thank You' letter from George Walrath, Grand Commander of the new St. Guanella Caravan in Jackson, for Sancho's \$500 donation to their charity start-up fund. He also read a note of appreciation from the **James Ciennik** family following the recent passing of Sultana Mary Ciennik.

A motion was passed to purchase a table of ten in support of the K of C Oktoberfest fundraiser dinner on October 25th. The cost is \$390. Names will be drawn at Sancho's membership meeting on October 10th.

St. Francis Camp's Fall clean-up weekend will be held November 30th. The camp is currently looking to hire a new on-site director and PSC Ed Smith is "retiring" as camp president.

Any member who wants to get more active in the caravan please consider running for a spot on our Divan. Just come to our election meeting on October 10th. The rewards you'll get are well worth it.


So attend the election meeting and enjoy the company of our many hard working Lady Nobles and Sir Nobles who make Sancho a successful, sustaining caravan.

The 2019 camping season at St. Francis Camp on the Lake is over. 151 campers enjoyed time on the lake, played on the new playscape, ate delicious camp-style meals and participated in various games and activities at the beautiful camp site in Jerome, Michigan.

The St. Francis Camp Board of Directors is already preparing for the 2020 camping season. At our September 2019 meeting the Board agreed to the 2020 Improvement and Renovation Funding Campaign. (Camp needs include beds & mattresses, stove, electrical upgrades, flooring, pumps, A/C)

Our goal is \$25000 this year to achieve these projects. This year an anonymous donor has already agreed to match up to \$10000 to help out with this campaign. The only stipulation of this matching grant is that the donor will only match donations from individuals.
